| Facilities: | <p>The Jenison High School Aquatics Center is a 16-lane pool. Any combination between 8 and 16 lanes of competition may be used. If more than 8 lanes of competition are used there will be at least 2 lanes open between the courses for supervised warm-up and warm-down. When only 8 lanes are used for competition, the other 8 lanes will be available for supervised warm-up and warm-down (with the middle two lanes closed). Depth at the start of the east pool is 13'11" and 8'9" at the turn. Depth at the start of the west pool is 8'9" and 4'10" at the turn. Movable starting blocks and non-turbulent lane markers will be used. IST timing with an 8 or 16 lane display will be used. There is ample balcony seating for spectators. Lockers are available (<i>provide your own lock</i>). Public phones will be available. <i>[The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4)]</i></p> |
| Eligibility: | <p>The 2014 Great Lakes Tropical Challenge is open to all level of swimmers with no entry time qualifications. All swimmers must be currently registered with United States of America Swimming (USA-S). A swimmer's age on Friday, January 17, 2014, will determine his/her eligibility for a particular age group</p> |
| Deck Registration: | <p>Unregistered swimmers <i>must</i> register on deck at this meet <i>by turning in the athlete registration form and payment to the Meet Referee. The cost of registering on deck is double the normal fee (\$124.00 per swimmer for 2013-14 registration).</i></p> |
| Meet Format: | <p><i>This meet will be a prelim/final format for all swimmers 11 and older. Eleven</i> & older swimmers will compete together in the morning and be split out for separate events (11/12, 13/14, & 150) at night. Open events will remain open at night with 3 total heats. All final events will consist of a bonus heat (17th-24th), consolation heat (9th-16th), and championship heat (1st-8th), swum in that order.</p> <p>All 10U swimmers will swim in an afternoon timed final session.</p> |
| Entry Limits: | <p>Entries will be accepted on a first come first serve basis by date of email for electronic entries and date of receipt by the entry chair for hard copy entries until the Michigan Swimming Four (4) hour per session maximum time limit is met. As set forth in entry procedures below, (A) a hard copy of your club's entry summary sheet, (B) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (C) your club's certification of entered athletes and (D) your club's entry and entry fees must be received by the Entry Chair in a timely fashion prior to the start of the meet, or your swimmers will not be allowed to swim in the meet. Entries received after the four (4) hour per session time limit has been met will be returned even if received before the entry deadline.</p> |
| Swimmers Without A | <p>Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach,</p> |

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| Coach: | must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. |
| Individual Entry Limits: | Friday: Athletes may swim a maximum of two (2) events. Saturday and Sunday: Timed Final afternoon swimmers will be limited to five (5) individual events per day. Prelim/Final swimmers will be limited to three (3) individual events per day. |
| Electronic Entries: | \$5.00 per event for all timed final events and \$7.50 per event for all prelim/final events. Please include a \$1.00 Michigan Swimming surcharge for each swimmer entered. Make checks payable to: RAYS |
| Paper Entries: | MS rules regarding non-electronic entries apply. \$6.00 per individual event for all timed final events and \$8.50 per individual event for all prelim/final events. There is a \$1.00 additional charge per individual event paid if the entry is not submitted in Hy-Tek format. The Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge for each swimmer also applies to paper entries. Paper entries may be submitted to the entry chair on a spreadsheet of your choice however the paper entry <i>must</i> be logically formatted and must contain all pertinent information to allow the entry chair to easily enter the swimmer(s) in the correct events with correct seed times. |
| Entry Procedures: | <p>Entries may be submitted to the entry chairperson as of Friday, December 20, 2013 at 12:00 PM (noon). The entry chairperson must receive all entries no later than Friday, January 10. Entries must include correct swimmer name (as registered with USA/MS Swimming), age and USA number. You can import the order of events and event numbers from the Michigan Swimming website (http://www.miswim.org/). All individual entries should be submitted via electronic mail to the entry chairperson at Rays_entries@hotmail.com.</p> <p>All entries will be processed in order by email date code or mail date code. Any entries submitted will be considered provisional until such time as the entry chairperson has received a hard copy of: (a) your club's entries (Team Manager Meet Entries Report), (b) a hard copy of your club's signed release/waiver agreement (c) your clubs signed certification of entered athletes and (d) your club's entry fees. This must be received in a timely fashion prior to the start of the meet or your swimmers will not be allowed to swim in the meet. The complete GLTC entry packet with entry forms is available on the Michigan Swimming Website at http://www.miswim.org/</p> <p>* Time updates will be accepted until 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Tuesday, January 15. No new entries or additional events to existing entries will be accepted once the meet is full or after the entry deadline, whichever comes first.</p> |
| Refunds: | Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed by the entry chair there are no refunds in full or in part unless the "over qualification exception" applies (see MS Rules). |

| <p>Check In:</p> | <p>Check In will be available as of 30 minutes prior to the beginning of warm-up. Check in is mandatory for all events and is required by the time set forth in this meet announcement. Failure to check in will cause the swimmer to be scratched from all events in that session. <i>Check in will close 15 minutes after the start of warm up for each session. <u>Check in sheets will be separated by gender and located in the pool hallway/lobby area and be clearly posted.</u></i></p> |
| <p>Scratch Rules:</p> | <p><u>Prelims and Timed Finals:</u> Prior to check in closing a swimmer may scratch events at the Clerk of Course. After check in closes, you must see the Meet Referee to scratch an event.</p> <p><u>Finals:</u> If preliminary swimmers have no intention of returning to swim at finals, regardless of place of finish, each swimmer must scratch at the Clerk of Course. Results for preliminary events will be posted at the Clerk of Course and you may scratch an event up to 30 minutes past the announced results for your event. After 30 minutes results will be final for the evening session.</p> <p>Due to the length of each preliminary event because of all ages swimming together, an individual sheet per event will be provided so that you may scratch in a timely fashion, regardless of place or finish. If you know you are going to scratch, find your event and CLEARLY write your name on the sheet provided at the Clerk of Course. These sheets will be pulled 30 minutes after the results are announced. | <p>Marshaling:</p> | <p><i>There is no marshaling in this meet. Heat sheets will be posted for self-marshaling for all age groups underneath the American Flag and the scoreboard.</i></p> |
| <p>Seeding:</p> | <p><i>All Friday evening Open events (500 Free, 400 IM and 1000 Free) will either be seeded fastest to slowest alternating genders by event after check in closes, or will swim in two separate courses (like 2013). Girls would swim in one pool</i></p> |

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| | <p><i>and boys would swim in the other pool. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event.</i></p> <p><i>All preliminary events will be circle seeded after check in closes. All 10 & Under events will be seeded slowest to fastest after check in closes, with all female heats of that event being swum first. Swimmers who fail to check in for an event will be scratched from that event.</i></p> <p><u>NOTE: During Friday night events and Saturday and Sunday preliminary sessions, between 8 and 16 lanes may be used for competition. We ask that each swimmer entered supply a timer and /or counter. This is not required, but highly recommended. All volunteer timers and/or counters must check in at the volunteer check-in in the pool hallway to receive a volunteer t-shirt or tag before entering the pool deck area.</u></p> |
| Deck Entries / Time Trials: | Deck entries will only be accepted from swimmers who are already entered into the meet. We will not be taking any new deck entries. Deck entries will be accepted if space and time allows. However, time trials will not be offered. The deck entry fee will be \$7.50 per individual event. Deck entry swimmers are subject to the Michigan Swimming \$1.00 general surcharge. |
| Meet Programs / Admissions: | <p>Admission is \$5.00 per day. Children 8 & under are free.</p> <p>Programs will not be available (Bring or print or read through the meet packet Prior to the meet for all meet information).</p> <p>Friday Finals, Saturday Finals, and Sunday Finals Heat Sheets will be \$2.00. Saturday/Sunday Prelims and Saturday/Sunday Timed Final Heat Sheets will be \$3.00. Heat sheets will be sold each session at the concession stand or at the admissions table (or both). Heat Sheets will be brought upstairs and announced as available as soon as possible. Please listen for the announcement.</p> |
| Scoring: | No scores will be kept. |
| Awards: | <p><i>FRIDAY/SATURDAY/SUNDAY NIGHT FINALS – Only “12 & Under” and 11/12 swimmers will receive awards. There are no awards for 13/14, 15 & Over, and Open events.</i></p> <p>PRELIMINARIES – No awards will be given for preliminary events. However, random prizes for all age groups will be awarded during tropical/musical heats.</p> <p>SATURDAY/SUNDAY TIMED FINALS – Individual events for 8 & Under, 9/10, and 11/12s will have medals awarded for 1st – 3rd and consolation finalist ribbons awarded for 4th – 16th. There are no awards for 17th-24th.</p> <p>NOTE: This is a prelim/final championship meet format meaning only the top eight seeds will compete for the top eight places. Consolation round (9th seed thru 16th seed) and bonus round (17th seed thru 24th seed) swimmers cannot move up or down a heat (i.e. swimmers competing in the top 8, middle 8, and bottom 8 are locked into placing within those heats.).</p> <p>All awards must be picked up by the coaches at the conclusion of Sunday finals. **If you need to pick up awards sooner, coaches must make this known to the office staff prior to needing the awards.</p> |
| Results: | Complete meet results will be posted on the Michigan Swimming Website at |

Jenison Aquatics results will be posted after the final results have been processed by the Michigan Swimming Office. Live results will be posted as soon as possible during the preliminaries. These will be available at www.jenisonaquatics.org. Live results will allow you to determine your child's position at the finals.</p> <p><i>Remember, if your child has no intention of swimming in finals, regardless of position, he/she must scratch that evening event at the Clerk of Course within 30 minutes of the results being announced.</i> Results will be emailed out to all Entry Chairs at the conclusion of the meet and posted on the main page of www.jenisonaquatics.org for 30 days. Results will also be available on flash drive (HY-TEK Team Manager result file) upon request. Teams must provide their own flash drive.</p> |
| Concessions: | Food and beverages will be available in the upstairs balcony. No food or beverage will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms. A hospitality area will be available for coaches and officials. |
| Lost and Found: | Articles may be turned in/picked up at <i>the pool office</i> . Articles not picked up by the end of the meet will be retained by the Meet Director or a representative for at least 14 days (<i>any longer period shall be in the sole discretion of the Meet Director</i>). |
| Swimming Safety: | Michigan Swimming warm up rules will be followed. To protect all swimmers during warm-ups, swimmers are required to enter the pool feet first at all times except when sprint lanes have been designated. No jumping or diving. <i>[The same rules will apply with respect to the warm-down pool and diving well]</i> . Penalties for violating these rules will be in the sole discretion of the meet referee which may include ejection from the meet. Controlled, supervised warm-up sessions may be utilized in accordance with the "warm-up procedure guidelines" suggested by USA Swimming. |
| Deck Personnel / Locker Rooms / Credentialing: | <p>Only registered and current coaches, athletes, officials and meet personnel are allowed on the deck or in locker rooms. Access to the pool deck may only be granted to any other individual in the event of emergency through approval by the Meet Director or the Meet Referee. The General Chair of MS and the Program Operations Vice-Chair of MS are authorized deck personnel at all MS meets. Personal assistants/helpers of athletes with a disability shall be permitted when requested by an athlete with a disability or a coach of an athlete with a disability.</p> <p>Lists of registered coaches, certified officials and meet personnel will be posted in the pool lobby. Meet personnel will check the list of approved individuals and issue a credential to be displayed at all times during the meet. This credential will include the host team [JAWS] as well as the function of the individual being granted access to the pool deck (Coach, Official, Timer, or Meet Personnel). In order to obtain a credential, Coaches and Officials must be current in all certifications through the final date of the meet. Meet personnel must return the credential at the conclusion of working each day and be reissued a credential daily.</p> <p>All access points to the pool deck and locker rooms will either be secured or staffed by a meet worker checking credentials throughout the duration of the meet.</p> |

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| Swimmers with Disabilities: | All swimmers are encouraged to participate. If any of your swimmers have special needs or requests please indicate them on the entry form and with the Clerk of Course and/or the Meet Referee during warm ups. |
| General Info: | Any errors or omissions in the program will be documented and signed by the meet Referee and available for review at the Clerk of Course for Coaches review. Information will also be covered at the Coaches' Meeting. |
| First Aid: | Supplies will be kept with the lifeguard on duty. |
| Facility Items: | <p>(A) No smoking is allowed in the building or on the grounds of Jenison High School Aquatic Center.</p> <p>(B) Pursuant to applicable Michigan law, no glass will be allowed on the deck of the pool or in the locker rooms.</p> <p>(C) No bare feet allowed outside of the pool area. Swimmers need to have shoes to go into the hallway to awards or concessions. (anywhere other than the pool deck and locker rooms).</p> <p>(D) An Emergency Action Plan has been submitted by the Host Club to the Safety Chair and the Program Operations Chair of Michigan Swimming prior to sanction of this meet and is available for review and inspection at the <i>pool office</i>.</p> <p>(E) To comply with USA Swimming privacy and security policy, <u>the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.</u></p> <p>(F) Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is <i>prohibited</i>.</p> |
