

SPRING & SUMMER 2024 MEEUS

First, it's important to understand that we can only generalize so much when it comes to talking about meets – our suggestions on meets for a new-to-BAC 9 year old will be different than for one of our Senior swimmers. So read the general advice, but connect with your lead coach if you have any questions on the meet plan for your swimmer!

DFAC SPRING SPLASH: This is the only SCY (25 yard) meet on the spring schedule, and it's especially designed for spring-only BACers that are looking for a 'tune-up' meet before summer rec league starts. Some groups (older, spring/summer swimmers) will be asked to prioritize other meets and sit this one out. One note on the format of the meet. The PM session of the meet is only for 8-under and 10-under swimmers. 11-up swimmers must all sign up for the 'Open' events in the AM. These Open events are also broken down by age group – 12A is the 8-under 200 Free, 12B is the 9-10 200 Free, 12C 11-12 and so on. This is done so all ages can swim together, but get broken out into age groups to determine awards – but can be confusing for even veteran BACers!

THE DEADLINE IS THURSDAY, APRIL 18TH. The meet is limited in size of the entry they'll accept, so we want to get our entry in well ahead of the deadline :^)

VARIOUS LCM MEETS: We have a number of different LCM meets on our schedule. Most of them are in June and are for spring/summer BACers only. But we do have two in May – the SEA Early Bird and the SSTY Sprint/Distance Meet. Those are on the schedule especially for spring/summer BACers to get some LCM experience in May, but they ARE available to interested spring-only BACers as well. We'll have more info on each meet as they get posted, or just reach out to your lead coach if you have any questions.

THE DEADLINE FOR THE SEA EARLY BIRD IS THURSDAY, APRIL 18TH, and we'll be posting the SSTY and other meets soon!

THE JACK PETTINGER INVITE: The 3rd annual JPI is the only meet BAC hosts for the spring/summer season. Previously it was restricted to only spring/summer BACers, but for the first time we're opening it up to everyone! The meet is a premier competitive experience, drawing most of the best teams in WI, teams from Illinois, lowa, and Minnesota, and several college teams including the UW Badgers! Attending swimmers need to have LSC state cuts in order to participate, but that restriction doesn't apply to BAC swimmers. BACers are eligible for any event, though coaches will restrict sign-up to LCM events that would be appropriate for each swimmer.

THE DEADLINE FOR THE JPI IS THURSDAY, MAY 9TH
