We're kicking our Spring 2025 educational series off with a great guest speaker – Joel Rollings. Joel has spent decades in the sport of swimming – much of it in Wisconsin – and has a great reputation across the state and beyond.



Joel swam for UW Milwaukee in the 90s and went immediately into coaching after graduating. In the 90s and early 2000s, Joel coached at a variety of schools and clubs under some notable coaches, including here in Wisconsin for the Germantown Seahawks. In 2006 he found his way back to our state as the Head Coach of both the Men's and Women's programs at UW-Whitewater. While there he was the 5-time WIAC coach of the year, coached 2 NCAA Champions and his swimmers absolutely rewrote the school record book, setting 92 different school records during his time.

In 2023 Joel was hired to start a brand new program from scratch at the Milwaukee School of Engineering.
