



MEET UPDATES – A+, IMR, GROUNDHOG

We have a couple of updates on some of the remaining meets – Schroeder A+, the IMR Meet, and the BAC Groundhog Open

First, REMEMBER THAT THE DEADLINE FOR THE A+ MEET AND THE IMR MEET IS THIS THURSDAY!

For **SSTY A+**, you can check the eligibility report to see what your swimmer is qualified for – remember that 12-unders get a ton of bonus while 13-overs do not. We can also add swims or swimmers that achieve a cut this weekend at the January Classic – email Coach Jacob if that's the case for your swimmer.

For the **IMR meet**, we have an update on the timing of the meet and on the events offered. The meet will start at 9:05am at Waukesha South, with an 8:00am warm-up. Given the early(ish) start and the travel time, we will NOT be doing any bussing to and from the meet. (It's something that we'll explore next year, but loading at the park and ride at 6:30am didn't seem like a great fit!)

The meet will start and end with a relay – swimmers will be on one or the other. The individual events offered are...

- For 'open' (13-up) swimmers
 - 200 Free, 200 IM, 50 Free, 100 Fly, 100 Free, 100 Back, 100 Breast
- For 9-12 swimmers
 - 200 Free, 100 IM, 50 Free, 50 Fly, 100 Free, 50 Back, 50 Breast
- There are also some distance events offered – the Open 1000 and 12-under 500 – but we'll likely restrict our entries in those events.
- Swimmers can do a maximum of 4 individual events

The sign-up on the web currently is an initial one to gauge the level of interest. Next week we will send the swimmers who registered some follow-up information on selecting events, and some other details on plans for the meet.

Finally, some initial information on plans for our **Groundhog Open**. (If you'll recall, we had initially planned to host on 2/08 at Middleton, but the pool became unavailable.)

We've been able to secure West HS for the meet instead, still on Saturday, 2/08. This was our #1 choice for a back-up plan, so we're excited it worked out! This will be a 'regular meet' (as opposed to an intrasquad) with VAST, STRM, and WAT all expressing an interest in attending. We do NOT have the meet information finalized, but I've attached a DRAFT of the likely events offered. We plan to post the meet sometime next week.

As we've said before, the end of the season can be a bit of flurry, with a LOT to stay on top of!

Communication is important, so make sure you're reading the emails that go out and **definitely reach out if you have any questions!**
