### LAST CALL FOR THE WAUKESHA IMR MEET

We actually already had the 'last call' for this meet, BUT then the meet host made some changes to the meet file, extending our deadline.

Swimmers in the meet already got a note, but basically the "12-under" 50s are now "Open" 50s and therefore available for 13-over swimmers.

### SPRING AND SUMMER MEET SCHEDULE PUBLISHED

For those of you that like to plan ahead! We've posted the (technically tentative, but we feel locked in on +90% of it) spring/summer 2026 Meet Schedule on the website and also attached it here! You can find it on the website under the 'meets' tab on the website. A couple of notes on the schedule

- TWO special events!
  - On April 18<sup>th</sup> we'll be hosting a single-day SWIM CAMP with a premier athlete! More details on this to come!
  - We'll also have a 2026 version of what's become a great summer event – our annual golf outing! This is our third year and we're looking to make some great adjustments to the event, but don't quite have all of the details locked in yet!
- The spring and summer offer both SCY ('short course yard', or 25y like we've been doing all fall/winter) and LCM ('long course meter', or 50m like the Olympics) meets. And just like the fall/winter not every swimmer does every meet – these are just the options that are available
- We're also hosting the 2026 Multi-Cultural Zones meet at the UW Soderholm on June 19<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup>. This is a huge honor and something we're really excited about and we'll have more details as the spring session gets underway!
