A FEW QUICK NOTES ON THE REMAINING SCY MEETS!

12-UNDER SINGLE AGE STATE

We've already emailed an update to all qualifiers. If you feel you have a qualified swimmer but did NOT get the update, please let Coach Jacob know ASAP!

JANUARY CLASSIC

The January Classic is now posted on our website and open for sign-up! As always, you can read a quick description of the meet on the [PARENT INFORMATION DOCUMENT](#). This is a three-day meet with distance events on Friday, and a variety of events spread over both Saturday and Sunday. This is typically a GREAT meet for swimmers to expand their horizons a bit and do either brand new events or events they haven't done in a while. That's particularly the case this year given our new IMR Reward meet.

MID-STATES ALL-STAR MEET

This is a little bit different of a meet opportunity for some swimmers. This is NOT a 'BAC meet', though it's a meet we certainly approve of attending. Swimmers sign up through the Wisconsin LSC and participate as part of 'Team Wisconsin'. Swimmers need at least one USA Swimming 'A time' (comparable to but generally faster than a state cut, especially for boys and younger swimmers) to apply, and then a team is selected from all of the applicants.

IMR REWARD MEET

LSC CHAMPIONSHIP MEETS

Swimmers do NOT have to qualify for the Regional Championship meet – this is the season-ending meet for most BACers!
